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18	Plaintiff Gary Brush ("plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se in this civil rights action	
19	pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to

21	On February 3, 2009, the Magistrate Judge filed a Findings and Recommendations herein which	
22	was served on the parties and which contained notice to the parties that any objection to the Findings	
23	and Recommendations was to be filed within thirty days. The parties have not filed timely objections	
24	to the Findings and Recommendations.	
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In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings and Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.¹ Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1.
