HARPER, et al., (Doc. 74) 13 Defendants. 14 15 Plaintiff Gary H. Brush ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se in this civil 16 rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States 17 Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 72-302. On March 10, 2009, the Magistrate Judge filed a Findings and Recommendations herein 18 19 which was served on Plaintiff, and which contained notice to Plaintiff that any objection to the 20 Findings and Recommendations was to be filed within thirty days. Plaintiff filed an objection on 21 May 19, 2009, after receiving an extension of time. 22 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the 23 24 Findings and Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis. 25 Accordingly, the Court HEREBY ORDERS that: 26 1. The Findings and Recommendations, filed on March 10, 2009, is adopted in full; 27 2. Defendants Freeland, Scott, Tucker, Soares, and Naftzger are DISMISSED from 28 this action without prejudice; 1
