1	under the Equal Access to Justice Act (EAJA), 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d), in the amount of four
2	thousand one hundred forty-eight dollars and ninety two cents (\$4,178.92). This amount was
3	calculated by multiplying the number of billable hours (23.7) by the attorney hourly rate of
4	\$175.06 which this Court finds is reasonable ($175.06 \times 23.7 = 4,148.92$).
5	Fees shall be made payable to Plaintiff, but if the Department of the Treasury determines
7	that Plaintiff does not owe a federal debt, then the government shall cause the payment of fees
8	and expenses to be made directly to Sengthiene Bosavanh, pursuant to the assignment executed
9	by Plaintiff. Any payments made shall be delivered to Plaintiff's counsel, Sengthiene Bosavanh.
10	This award is without prejudice to the rights of Plaintiff's counsel to seek Social Security
11	Act attorney fees under 42 U.S.C. § 406, subject to the provisions of the EAJA.
