3. Defense reply papers would serve to delay disposition of the summary judgment motions; This Court thoroughly reviews, considers and applies the evidence it deems admissible, 4. material and appropriate for summary judgment/adjudication and thus does not rule on objections in a summary judgment context; and 5. Disobedience of this Court's order is not a "transgression" and warrants prohibition of defense reply papers. Again, this Court ADMONISHES defendants that it will strike defense reply papers of any kind. IT IS SO ORDERED. Dated: October 22, 2009 /s/ Lawrence J. O'Neill
