On May 23, 2012, the Court 14 ordered Plaintiff to show cause why this action should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute. 15 Plaintiff filed a response on June 20, 2012. 16 17 In a separate order, the Court referred this case to the Pro Bono Program of the Eastern District of California to seek counsel to represent Plaintiff. In light of that referral, it is HEREBY 18 19 ORDERED that: 20 1. The order to show cause, filed on May 23, 2012, is discharged; and 2.
