ORDER FINDING SERVICE OF COMPLAINT APPROPRIATE, AND FORWARDING SERVICE DOCUMENTS TO PLAINTIFF FOR COMPLETION AND RETURN

(Doc. 1)

Plaintiff is a civil detainee proceeding pro se in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The court screened plaintiff’s complaint pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B) and finds that it states cognizable claims for relief under section 1983 against defendants Mayberg, McClain, and Maynard for violation of the Due Process Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment. Fed. R. Civ. P. 8(a); Swierkiewicz v. Sorema N. A., 534 U.S. 506, 512-15 (2002); Hydrick v. Hunter, 466 F.3d 676, 697 (9th Cir. 2006). Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that:
