(Doc. 17) 14 Plaintiff Shaulton Mitchell ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma 15 pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff filed his original complaint 16 17 on September 12, 2007. (Doc. 1.) Plaintiff filed his first amended complaint on March 17, 2008. (Doc. 14.) The Court dismissed Plaintiff's first amended complaint with leave to amend on June 17, 18 19 2008. (Doc. 16.) Plaintiff filed a second amended complaint on July 21, 2008. (Doc. 17.) The 20 Court has screened Plaintiff's second amended complaint pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A and finds that service is appropriate. Fed. R. Civ. P. 8(a); Erickson v. Pardus, 127 S.Ct. 2197, 2200 (2007); 21 22 Alvarez v. Hill, 518 F.3d 1152, 1157-58 (9th Cir. 2008). 9	2.	The Clerk of the Court shall send Plaintiff nine (9) USM-285 forms, nine (9)
10		summonses, a Notice of Submission of Documents form, an instruction sheet and a
11		copy of the second amended complaint filed July 21, 2008.
12	3.	Within thirty (30) days from the date of this order, Plaintiff shall complete the
13		attached Notice of Submission of Documents and submit the completed Notice to the
14		Court with the following documents:
15		a. Completed summons;
16		b. One completed USM-285 form for each defendant listed above; and
17		c. Ten (10) copies of the endorsed second amended complaint filed July 21,
18		2008.
19	4.	Plaintiff need not attempt service on Defendants and need not request waiver of
20		service. Upon receipt of the above-described documents, the Court will direct the
21		United States Marshal to serve the above-named defendants pursuant to Federal Rule
22		of Civil Procedure 4 without payment of costs.
23	5.	The failure to comply with this order will result in a recommendation that this action
24		be dismissed.
