On October 26, 2007, Plaintiff filed a 16 17 corrected Application to Proceed In Forma Pauperis by a Prisoner (Doc. #5). The Court granted Plaintiff in forma pauperis status on December 3, 2007. (Doc. #4.) On January 9, 18 19 2009, Plaintiff filed a Notice of Change of Address, indicating that he was released from 20 prison and is now residing in Pixley, California. (Doc. #18). He will be ordered to pay the 21 filing fee or to show cause why he is unable to do so. I. 22 **Payment of Filing Fee** 23 When bringing an action, a prisoner must either pay the filing fee in a lump sum or, 24 if granted the privilege of proceeding in forma pauperis, pay the fee incrementally as set 25 forth in 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b)(1). Because Plaintiff was a prisoner when he filed this action, 26 he must pay the \$350.00 filing fee. 27

<sup>1</sup> Because Plaintiff's corrected Application was granted, his first Application to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis* (Doc. #2) will be denied as moot.

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On January 9, 2009, Plaintiff filed a notice of change of address reflecting that he has been released from prison. None of the filing fee has been paid. Because Plaintiff has been released and he has not paid the filing fee, he must notify the Court within 30 days from the filing date of this Order whether he intends to pay the filing fee in full or show good cause in writing why he cannot pay the fee. Plaintiff may show cause by submitting an affidavit, signed under penalty of perjury, demonstrating why he is presently unable to pay the filing fee. See 28 U.S.C. § 1746 (the oath requirement may be satisfied when a person declares under penalty of perjury that the submission is true and correct, and signs and dates the statement). An application to proceed *in forma pauperis* is attached, which may assist Plaintiff in the preparation of such an affidavit. Failure to comply with this Order will result in the dismissal of this action.

## II. Warnings

### A. Address Changes

Plaintiff must file and serve a notice of a change of address in accordance with Rule 83-182(f) and 83-183(b) of the Local Rules of Civil Procedure. Plaintiff must not include a motion for other relief with a notice of change of address. Failure to comply may result in dismissal of this action.

#### B. Copies

Plaintiff must submit an additional copy of every filing for use by the Court. <u>See</u> LRCiv 5-133(d)(2). Failure to comply may result in the filing being stricken without further notice to Plaintiff.

#### C. Possible Dismissal

If Plaintiff fails to timely comply with every provision of this Order, including these warnings, the Court may dismiss this action without further notice. See Ferdik v. Bonzelet, 963 F.2d 1258, 1260-61 (9th Cir. 1992) (a district court may dismiss an action for failure to comply with any order of the court).

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# 1 IT IS ORDERED: 2 Plaintiff's first Application to Proceed In Forma Pauperis (Doc. #2) is denied (1) 3 as moot. 4 Within 30 days from the filing date of this Order, Plaintiff must either pay the (2) 5 \$350.00 balance of the filing fee or show good cause why he is unable to do so. (3) If Plaintiff fails, within 30 days from the filing date of this Order, either to pay 6 the \$350.00 balance of the filing fee or to show good cause why he is unable to pay the 7 balance of the filing fee, the Clerk of Court must enter a judgment of dismissal of this action 8 9 without prejudice or further notice. 10 **(4)** The Clerk of Court must mail Plaintiff a court-approved form for filing an 11 Application to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis* (Non-Habeas) as a guideline in the event that 12 Plaintiff seeks to show good cause why he is unable to pay the filing fee. 13 DATED this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of August, 2009. 14 15 16 17 18 19 United States District Judge 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28

# Instructions for Prisoners Applying for Leave to Proceed *in Forma Pauperis* Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915 in a Civil Action (Non-habeas) in Federal Court

You must pay the full filing fee of \$350.00 for a civil action. If you later file an appeal, you will be obligated to pay the \$455.00 filing fee for the appeal.

If you have enough money to pay the full filing fee, you should send a cashier's check or money order payable to the Clerk of the Court with your complaint, petition, or notice of appeal.

If you do not have enough money to pay the full filing fee, you can file the action without prepaying the filing fee. However, the court will assess an initial partial filing fee. The initial partial filing fee will be the greater of 20% of the average monthly deposits or 20% of the average monthly balance in your prison or jail account for the six months immediately preceding the filing of the lawsuit. The court will order the agency that has custody of you to withdraw the initial partial filing fee from your prison or jail account as soon as funds are available and to forward the money to the court.

After the initial partial filing fee has been paid, you will owe the balance of the filing fee. Until the filing fee is paid in full, each month you will owe 20% of your preceding month's income. The agency that holds you in custody will collect that money and forward it to the court any time the amount in your account exceeds \$10.00. The balance of the filing fee may be collected even if the action is later dismissed, summary judgment is granted against you, or you fail to prevail at trial.

To file an action without prepaying the filing fee, and to proceed with an action *in forma pauperis*, you must complete the attached form and return it to the court with your complaint. You must have a prison or jail official complete the certificate on the bottom of the form and attach a certified copy of your prison or jail account statement for the last six months. If you were incarcerated in a different institution during any part of the past six months, you must attach a certificate and a certified copy of your account statement from <u>each</u> institution at which you were confined. If you submit an incomplete form or do not submit a prison or jail account statement with the form, your request to proceed *in forma pauperis* will be denied.

Even if some or all of the filing fee has been paid, the court is required to dismiss your action if: (1) your allegation of poverty is untrue; (2) the action is frivolous or malicious; (3) your complaint does not state a claim upon which relief can be granted; or (4) your complaint makes a claim against a defendant for money damages and that defendant is immune from liability for money damages.

If you file more than three actions or appeals which are dismissed as frivolous or malicious or for failure to state a claim on which relief can be granted, you will be prohibited from filing any other action *in forma pauperis* unless you are in imminent danger of serious physical injury.
