17 On January 15, 2009, Petitioner Henry J. Parson, Jr., the guardian ad litem of the minor
18 JMP, filed a petition for an order approving the compromise of the minor's claim.
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20 On February 23, 2009, the Magistrate Judge issued [Findings and Recommendations](#) that
21 the Petition be granted. The Findings and Recommendations were served on all parties and
22 contained notice that any objections were to be filed within thirty (30) days. Over thirty (30)
23 days have passed and no objections have been filed.

24 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted
25 a *de novo* review of the case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court concludes that
26 the Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendations are supported by the record and proper
27 analysis.
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1 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

2 1. The Findings and Recommendations issued February 23, 2009, are ADOPTED IN
3 FULL;

4 2. The Petition for Order Approving Compromise of the Claim of Plaintiff, JMP, A
5 Minor, is GRANTED;

6 3. JMP's \$3,750.00 share of the settlement shall be deposited in an insured account
7 at Mission Bank, Main Branch, located at 1330 Truxtun Avenue, Bakersfield,
8 California, and not withdrawn without a court order or until JMP reaches the age
9 of majority; and

10 4. The sum of \$1,250.00 shall be paid to Rodriguez & Associates for attorney's fees.
