The matter was referred to a 20 21 United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. \$ 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 72-302. 22 23 On December 11, 2007, the Magistrate Judge filed Findings 24 and a Recommendation herein which were served on plaintiff and 25 which contained notice to plaintiff that any objections to the 26 Findings and Recommendation were to be filed within thirty (30) 27 days. To date, plaintiff has not filed objections to the

Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendation.

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 73-305, this Court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings and Recommendation to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- The Findings and Recommendation, filed December 11,
 are ADOPTED IN FULL; and,
- 2. This action is DISMISSED based on plaintiff's failure to obey the court's order of October 25, 2007.
