CERTIFIED COPY OF TRUST ACCOUNT 13 STATEMENT OR PAY FILING FEE KEVIN ELIJAH, et al, WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS 14 Defendants. 15 16 17 Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed a civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983, together with an application to proceed in forma pauperis pursuant to 28 18 19 U.S.C. § 1915. However, plaintiff's application to proceed in forma pauperis was deficient as follows: 20 21 The application did not include the required original signature by an authorized 22 officer of the institution of incarceration. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(2). 23 The application did not include a certified copy of plaintiff's prison trust account statement for the six month period immediately preceding the filing of the complaint. 28 U.S.C. 24 25 § 1915(a)(2). 26

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Plaintiff will be provided the opportunity to submit a new application to proceed in forma pauperis and a certified copy of his trust account statement, **or** to pay the \$350.00 filing fee.

## Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The Clerk's Office shall send plaintiff the form for application to proceed in forma pauperis.
- 2. Within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this order, plaintiff shall submit a completed application to proceed in forma pauperis and a certified copy of his prison trust account statement for the six month period immediately preceding the filing of the complaint, or in the alternative, to pay the \$350.00 filing fee for this action. Failure to comply with this order will result in a recommendation that this action be dismissed.
