10	Plaintiff is a prisoner proceeding pro se in this action that asserts violation of his civil rights	
18	according to 42 USC § 1983. Plaintiff filed this action on November 30, 2007. On May 25, 2010, the	
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20	On July 28, 2010, the Court issued its Second Scheduling Order setting forth the dates by which	
21	the matter would proceed to trial. (Doc. 59) Notably, the Court ordered Plaintiff to file his pretrial	
22	statement by November 5, 2010 and Defendants to file their statement by December 16, 2010. Id. In	
23	addition, any motions to obtain the attendance of incarcerated witnesses was to occur by November 5,	
24	2010. Id. at 3. To date, Plaintiff has failed to file his pretrial statement.	
25	Therefore, immediately, but no later than December 17, 2010, Plaintiff is ordered file his pretrial	
26	statement or show cause why this matter should not be dismissed due to his failure to comply with the	
27	Court's order.	
28	Defendants are ORDERED to file their pretrial statements within 21 days after Plaintiff files his	
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1	1 pretrial statement.(Doc. 63)	
2	2 Plaintiff is advised that his failure to comply with this order, will result in the Court	
3	dismissing his case based upon Plaintiff's failure to comply with the Court's orders.
