On February 16, 2011, the Court received a document entitled “Motion” from Plaintiff Steve Olson, a state prisoner who was proceeding pro se in this civil rights action. This action was closed following transfer to the Central District of California on December 19, 2007. It is not appropriate for Plaintiff to continue filings requests in this action. Filings pertaining to this action should be directed to the Central District of California and should set forth the case number assigned to the action following the transfer. If Plaintiff is attempting to seek relief from the Kern County Superior Court, he must file his motion with that court.
