TO ADMINISTRATIVELY REDESIGNATE
CASE AS A REGULAR CIVIL ACTION

Plaintiff Maximilian Monclova-Chavez (“Plaintiff”) is a federal prisoner proceeding in this civil action pursuant to Bivens v. Six Unknown Named Agents of Federal Bureau of Narcotics, 403 U.S. 388, 91 S.Ct. 1999 (1971), which provides a remedy for violation of civil rights by federal actors. The action was designated administratively as one involving a prisoner litigating the conditions of his jail confinement and has proceeded as such to this point in the litigation. The Court has determined that the proper designation for the case is as a regular civil action because all parties are represented by counsel.

Accordingly, the Clerk of the Court SHALL change the administrative designation of the present case to reflect that of a regular civil rights action (440).
