17	for consideration of equitable tolling. This is a theory that was not fully fleshed out in the	
18	underlying briefing on the summary judgment motion. Thus, the parties are ordered to provide	
19	additional briefing on the subject. Additionally, the parties must provide detail concerning	
20	California Tort Claim Act claims. Specifically, the court seeks documentary evidence as to when	
21	these claim(s) and denial(s) were sent and received. The parties must file the requested briefing	
22	by August 21, 2013.
