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15 Plaintiff has filed a motion for leave to file an amended complaint. Because there has  
16 been no appearance by any defendant, Plaintiff's motion is granted pursuant to Federal Rule of  
17 Civil Procedure 15(a).

18 Plaintiff is advised that his amended complaint should be brief, Fed. R. Civ. P. 8(a), but  
19 must state what each named defendant did that led to the deprivation of Plaintiff's constitutional  
20 or other federal rights, Hydrick, 500 F.3d at 987-88. Although accepted as true, the "[f]actual  
21 allegations must be [sufficient] to raise a right to relief above the speculative level . . . ." Bell  
22 Atlantic Corp. v. Twombly, 127 S.Ct. 1955, 1965 (2007) (citations omitted).

23 Plaintiff is also advised that an amended complaint supercedes the original complaint,  
24 Forsyth v. Humana, Inc., 114 F.3d 1467, 1474 (9th Cir. 1997); King v. Atiyeh, 814 F.2d 565, 567  
25 (9th Cir. 1987), and must be "complete in itself without reference to the prior or superceded  
26

1 pleading,” Local Rule 15-220. Plaintiff is warned that “[a]ll causes of action alleged in an  
2 original complaint which are not alleged in an amended complaint are waived.” King, 814 F.2d  
3 at 567 (citing to London v. Coopers & Lybrand, 644 F.2d 811, 814 (9th Cir. 1981)); accord  
4 Forsyth, 114 F.3d at 1474.

5 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff’s motion for leave to file an  
6 amended complaint is granted. Plaintiff’s amended complaint is due within thirty days of the  
7 date of service of this order.
