Jacquelyn Uhlman (“Plaintiff”) is a former state prisoner proceeding pro se in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.

On April 20, 2011, Findings and Recommendations were entered, recommending that this action be dismissed based on Plaintiff’s failure to state a claim upon which relief may be granted. Plaintiff was provided an opportunity to file objections to the Findings and Recommendations within thirty days. To date, Plaintiff has not filed objections or otherwise responded to the Findings and Recommendations.

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 304, this Court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings and Recommendations to be supported by the record and proper analysis.
