Plaintiff did not file a timely 23 Objection to the Findings and Recommendations. In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a 24 25 de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings 26 and Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis. /// 27 28 1
