16 Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding pro se in this civil rights action. The matter  
17 was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local  
18 Rule 72-302.

19 On November 19, 2009, [findings and recommendations](#) were entered,  
20 recommending dismissal of Plaintiff's motion for injunctive relief. Plaintiff was provided an  
21 opportunity to file objections within thirty days. Plaintiff has not filed objections to the findings  
22 and recommendations.

23 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(B) and Local Rule  
24 73-305, this court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the  
25 entire file, the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and  
26 proper analysis.

1 Accordingly, THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS that:

- 2 1. The Findings and Recommendations issued by the Magistrate Judge on  
3 November 19, 2009, are adopted in full; and  
4 2. Plaintiff's motion for injunctive relief filed on September 16, 2009, is denied.
