B. **Motion Two** 1 2 Plaintiff contends that Pelican Bay State Prison, where Plaintiff is currently housed, failed to comply with its own regulations regarding access to the law library and equipment. (Doc. 39, 3 Pl.'s Mot. 2.) Plaintiff seeks sanctions against Pelican Bay State Prison/California Department of 5 Corrections and Rehabilitation, as well as a court order for the harassment to cease. (Doc. 39, Pl.'s Mot. 3.) The Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation is not a party to this action, and injunctive relief is thus beyond the scope of the Court's jurisdiction. See Zepeda v. U.S. INS, 8 753 F.2d 719, 727 (9th Cir. 1985) ("A federal court may issue an injunction if it has personal jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter jurisdiction over the claim; it may not attempt to 10 determine the rights of persons not before the court."). Plaintiff's second motion, filed on 11 October 5, 2009, is DENIED. II. 12 **Conclusion and Order** 13 Accordingly, the Court HEREBY ORDERS that Plaintiff's motions, filed on October 5, 14 2009, are DENIED. 15 16 IT IS SO ORDERED. 17 Dated: October 7, 2009 /s/ Dennis L.
