WITCHER, et al., 8 (Doc. 7) Defendants. 9 10 Plaintiff Paul Antoine ("Plaintiff") is a former state prisoner proceeding pro se in this civil 11 action, which was removed from Kern County Superior Court on March 24, 2008, by Defendants 12 13 Witcher, Meadors, Avalos, Amos, Boyer, and Perez. On September 19, 2008, the Magistrate Judge dismissed Plaintiff's complaint for failure to state any claims upon which relief may be granted and 14 ordered Plaintiff to file an amended complaint within thirty days. 28 U.S.C. § 1915A. Plaintiff was 15 granted a thirty-day extension of time to amend on October 29, 2008. To date, Plaintiff has not 16 17 complied with or otherwise responded to the Court's order. As a result, there is no pleading on file which sets forth any claims upon which relief may be granted under section 1983. 18 19 Accordingly, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A, this action is HEREBY DISMISSED, with prejudice, based on Plaintiff's failure to state any claims upon which relief may be granted. 20 21 22 IT IS SO ORDERED. 23 Dated: January 22, 2009 /s/ Lawrence J.
