17 Anthony Samuel Cato ("plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se in this civil
18 rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate
19 Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 72-302.

20 On November 21, 2008, findings and recommendations were entered, recommending
21 that this action be dismissed based on plaintiff's failure to obey the court's order of August 4, 2008.
22 Plaintiff was provided an opportunity to file objections to the findings and recommendations within
23 thirty days. To date, plaintiff has not filed objections or otherwise responded to the findings and
24 recommendations.

25 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 73-
26 305, this court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire
27 file, the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and proper
28 analysis.
