TO THE MAGISTRATE JUDGE'S
FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS
OF APRIL 1, 2013
(Doc. 45.)

15 Jacques Fearance ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se with this civil rights
16 action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On April 1, 2013, findings and recommendations were
17 entered, recommending that this case proceed on the claims found cognizable by the court in
18 the Second Amended Complaint, with objections, if any, due in thirty days. (Doc. 45.) The
19 court inadvertently omitted its instructions for the parties to file objections. Therefore, the
20 parties shall now be given the court's instructions and granted thirty days in which to file
21 objections, if any.

22 The court's instructions are as follows:

23 The findings and recommendations issued on April 1, 2013, are submitted to the
24 United States District Judge assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of
25 Title 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). Within thirty days after from the date of this order,
26 the parties may file written objections to the findings and recommendations with
27 the court. Such a document should be captioned "Objections to Magistrate
28 Judge's Findings and Recommendations." Any reply to the objections shall be
served and filed within ten days after service of the objections. The parties are
advised that failure to file objections within the specified time may waive the
right to appeal the District Court's order. Martinez v. Ylst, 951 F.2d 1153 (9th
Cir. 1991).
