PLAINTIFF'S DEPOSITION BY
VIDEOCONFERENCE
(Doc. 78.)

12 Jaques Fearence ("Plaintiff") is a prisoner proceeding pro se in this civil rights action
13 pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. This case now proceeds on the Third Amended Complaint filed
14 by Plaintiff on November 22, 2013, against defendants Hopkins and Busby for use of excessive
15 force; against defendants Hopkins, Davis, Duffy, and Beckett for failure to protect Plaintiff;
16 and against defendants Hopkins, Busby, Davis, Duffy, and Beckett ("Defendants") for
17 conspiracy to use excessive force. (Doc. 64.)

18 This case is currently in the discovery phase, pursuant to the court's scheduling order
19 issued on February 19, 2014. (Doc. 74.) On March 13, 2014, Defendants filed a request for
20 leave to depose Plaintiff by videoconference. Fed. R. Civ. P. 30(b)(4). (Doc. 78.)

21 Good cause having been shown, Defendants' request is HEREBY GRANTED.
