12	A. Dunnahoe, V. Ybarra, G. Ybarra, S. Cunningham, Powell, Curliss, Velasquez, Medrano, Holguin,	
13	and J. Gonzalez. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C.	
14	§ 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.	
15	On May 14, 2010, the Magistrate Judge filed a Findings and Recommendations herein which	
16	was served on the parties and which contained notice to the parties that any objection to the Findings	
17	and Recommendations was to be filed within thirty days. Neither party filed an Objection to the	
18	Findings and Recommendations.
