12 Plaintiff Alfred C. Lombardelli (“Plaintiff”) is a California state prisoner proceeding pro se  
13 and in forma pauperis in this civil action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. This action is proceeding on  
14 Plaintiff’s complaint against Defendants Ortiz, Halsey, Smyth, Carter, and Vogel for violation of the  
15 First and Eighth Amendments.

16 Within **twenty (20) days** from the date of service of this order, Plaintiff and Defendants are  
17 each to file a written response indicating whether they would agree to participate in a settlement  
18 conference. If both parties agree, the Court will issue a further scheduling order setting this matter  
19 for settlement conference before a Magistrate Judge or District Judge from the United States District  
20 Court, Eastern District of California.
