ORDER RESPECTING
TRIAL WITNESSES

15 The parties “seek guidance . . . regarding several issues” regarding trial
 16 witnesses. ECF 504, at 2.

17 It is hereby **ORDERED** that by January 14, 2022, the parties are to
 18 identify which individuals they plan to bring to the trial to testify live; and it
 19 is further **ORDERED** that (1) the parties are to exchange initial deposition
 20 designations by no later than 10 days after January 14, 2022; (2) objections
 21 and counter-designations are to be exchanged no later than seven days after
 22 the initial designations are exchanged; and (3) objections to counter-designa-
 23 tions are to be exchanged no later than three days after the counter-designa-
 24 tions are exchanged.
