Plaintiff did 26 not prepay the \$350 filing fee mandated by 28 U.S.C. § 1914(a) to commence a civil action; 27 instead, he filed a Motion to Proceed In Forma Pauperis ("IFP") pursuant to 28 U.S.C.

§ 1915(a) [Doc. No. 3]. Because the allegations in Plaintiff's Complaint arose from incidents

which occurred at Corcoran State Prison, and no named Defendants were alleged to reside in the Central District, this matter was transferred to the Eastern District of California.

The Court granted Plaintiff's Motion to Proceed IFP on June 16, 2008 [Doc. No. 5]. On November 25, 2008, this matter was reassigned to Chief Judge Irma E. Gonzalez for all further proceedings [Doc. No. 7]. On December 10, 2008, this Court dismissed Plaintiff's Complaint without prejudice for failing to state a claim and for seeking money damages against immune Defendants pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2) & § 1915A(b). Plaintiff was granted forty five (45) days leave to file a First Amended Complaint. That time has passed and Plaintiff has not filed an Amended Complaint.

## **CONCLUSION AND ORDER**

Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

This action is **DISMISSED** without prejudice for all the reasons stated in the Court's previous Order and for failing to comply with the Court's December 10, 2008 Order. The Clerk shall enter judgment accordingly and close the file.
