On January 8, 2010, the Magistrate Judge issued <u>Findings and Recommendation</u> that the Motion for Good Faith Settlement Determination filed by Defendants National Railroad Passenger Corporation ("Amtrak") and Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad ("BNSF") be GRANTED. 4	2.	Defendants' Motion for Good Faith Settlement Determination is GRANTED;	
5	3.	The settlement agreement between Amtrak and BNSF and the Garcia Plaintiffs in	
6		the amount of \$10,000.00 is made in good faith pursuant to California Code of	
7		Civil Procedure Sections 877 and 877.6. All future cross-complaints filed in this	
8		action for equitable comparative relief, or partial or comparative indemnity based	
9		upon comparative negligence or comparative fault against Amtrak and BNSF, are	
10		barred.
