2	tabular data fo	or all of May 8, 2007, from the event data recorder on the subject train.

3 2. On or before April 27, 2010, the parties are to enter into a stipulated protective order 4 to protect the confidentiality of the agreement between Defendants Amtrak and BNSF concerning 5 the subject train tracks, and file the document with the Court.
