17	Petitioner is a state prisoner proceeding pro se with a petition for writ of habeas corpus	
18	pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. On January 25, 2010, the United States Magistrate Judge issued	
19	Findings and Recommendations to grant the petition. (Doc. 17). On March 31, 2010, the Court	
20	adopted those Findings and Recommendations and entered judgment in favor of Petitioner. (Docs.	
21	27 & 28). Respondent appealed to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit, and the	
22	case was docketed as case no. 10-15760. (Docs. 29 & 33). On April 23, 2010, the Ninth Circuit	
23	stayed proceedings pending further order of the Court. (Doc. 35).	
24	On May 20, 2010, the Ninth Circuit issued an order finding that the appointment of counsel	
25	to represent Petitioner "would benefit the court's review," and requiring this Court to "locate	
26	appointed counsel for [Petitioner]." The order further required this Court to send notification of the	
27	"name, address, and telephone number of appointed counsel to the Clerk of this courtwithin 14

days of locating counsel." **ORDER** Accordingly, the Court HEREBY ORDERS as follows: 1. The Federal Public Defenders Office is appointed to represent Petitioner in the instant case on appeal in case no. 10-15760; 2.
