No. 16]. 24 Accordingly, the Court sets the following briefing schedule: 25 1) Defendants' Motion to Dismiss is calendared for hearing on Friday, September 26 **4, 2009** at 11:00 a.m. in Courtroom 15. 27 2) Plaintiff, if he chooses, may file an Opposition to Defendants' Motion and serve 28 it upon Defendants' counsel of record no later than Friday, August 21, 2009.

3) Defendants may file a Reply to Plaintiff's Opposition, and serve it upon Plaintiff no later than **Friday**, **August 28**, **2009**.
