ASTRUE, ACCESS TO JUSTICE ACT, 28 U.S.C. 14 Commissioner of Social Security, § 2412(d) 15 Defendant. 16 17 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between the parties through their undersigned 18 counsel that, subject to the approval of the Court, Plaintiff be awarded attorney fees under the 19 Equal Access to Justice Act (EAJA), 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d), in the amount of TWO THOUSAND 20 dollars and 00/100 cents (\$2,000.00).1 This amount represents compensation for all legal 21 services rendered on behalf of Plaintiff by counsel in connection with this civil action, in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d). 22 This stipulation constitutes a compromise settlement of Plaintiff's request for EAJA 23 attorney fees, and does not constitute an admission of liability on the part of Defendant under the 2.4 25 1 Under the EAJA, a "prevailing party" must file an application for attorney fees "within thirty days of 26 final judgment." 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d)(1)(A), (B); see also Akopyan v. Barnhart, 296 F.3d 852, 854 (9th Cir. 2002). The Commissioner has waived the defense of timeliness in this case. Waiver applies to in 27 this case only and should not be construed as an intent to agree to waiver in any other case.

1	fees, shall constitute a complete release from and bar to any and all claims Plaintiff may have	
2	relating to EAJA fees in connection with this action. Any payment shall be delivered to

4	This award is without prejudice to the rights of Plaintiff's counsel to seek Social Security	
5	Act attorney fees under 42 U.S.C. § 406, subject to the provisions of the EAJA.
