15	Plaintiff Cesar Uribe ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis		
16	in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. An order to show cause hearing is scheduled		
17	for August 31, 2011, and writs have been issued to transport Plaintiff and Inmate Quiroz to court for		
18	the hearing. On August 15, 2011, the Court received a confidential letter from Inmate Quiroz		
19	expressing some concerns which shall be addressed in this order.		
20	The Court is aware of the safety and security concerns due to inmates testifying in court		
21	proceedings. Due to the concerns expressed, the Court has contacted the Litigation Coordinator at		
22	the institution where Inmate Quiroz is currently housed. Plaintiff and his witnesses are listed on		
23	Inmate Quiroz's enemy list and will not be housed in the same facility if they are at the same		
24	institution.		
25	Inmate Quiroz should only be needed to testify on August 31, 2011, and will be brought		
26	directly to court and returned to the facility on the same day. Therefore, the court appearance should		
27	not effect Inmate Uribe's current status at the institution where he is housed.
