1415 Plaintiff Matthew B. Cramer is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in
16 this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff filed this action on June 16, 2008. On
17 March 3, 2009, the Court dismissed Plaintiff's complaint for failure to state any claims upon which
18 relief may be granted, and ordered Plaintiff to file an amended complaint within thirty days. 28
19 U.S.C. § 1915A; 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e). To date, Plaintiff has not complied with or otherwise
20 responded to the Court's order. As a result, there is no pleading on file which sets forth any claims
21 upon which relief may be granted under section 1983.22 Accordingly, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A and 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e), this action is
23 HEREBY DISMISSED, with prejudice, based on Plaintiff's failure to state any claims upon which
24 relief may be granted under section 1983.25
