15	Plaintiff is a prisoner proceeding pro se in a civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983.
16	On October 21, 2009, this court entered an order on its own motion (doc. 18), extending the time for
17	plaintiff to file his amended complaint in light of the court's second order appointing pro bono
18	counsel (doc. 17). On October 23, 2009, the court received plaintiff' motion, prepared prior to the
19	court's sua sponte order, to omit claim while reserving right to assert the claim at a later date, or, in
20	the alternative, request for a 45-day extension of time to file amended complaint (doc. 19). Because
21	the court has already entered an order extending the time for plaintiff's submission of his amended
22	complaint, plaintiff's motion is moot.
23	Accordingly, plaintiff's motion to omit claim while reserving right to assert the claim at a
24	later date, or, in the alternative, request for a 45-day extension of time to file amended complaint is
25	hereby DISMISSED as moot.
