2	2) the party's assessment of what factors, if any, will prevent settlement of this matter prior to trial; and	
4	3) any additional information the court may find useful in determining whether to set this	
5	matter for a settlement conference.	
6	Should the Court determine this action to be appropriate to referral to the Prisoner	
7	Settlement Program, the Court will set this matter for settlement conference before a magistrate	
8	judge or district judge.
