19 This matter is before the Court on plaintiff United States’ *Ex Parte* Motion for Default
 20 Judgment and Final Judgment of Forfeiture filed August 14, 2009. The Magistrate Judge has
 21 recommended that the United States’ motion for default judgment be granted. The time for objecting
 22 to the Order Vacating Hearing on Plaintiff’s Renewed Motion for Default Judgment and Deeming
 23 Matter Submitted for Decision of the Magistrate Judge have passed and no timely objections have
 24 been filed. An Order Adopting Findings and Recommendations (Doc. 31) Order Granting Plaintiff’s
 25 Motion for Default Judgment (Doc. 29) Order Directing Clerk to Enter Judgment *-and-* Final
 26 Judgment of Forfeiture for Plaintiff was filed on February 18, 2010. Based on the Magistrate
 27 Judge’s Order Vacating Hearing on Plaintiff’s Renewed Motion for Default Judgment and Deeming
 28 Matter Submitted for Decision, the Order Adopting Findings and Recommendations (Doc. 31) Order

1 Granting Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment (Doc. 29) Order Directing Clerk to Enter Judgment
2 -and- Final Judgment of Forfeiture for Plaintiff, and the files and records of the Court, it is

3 ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:

4 1. The Court adopts the Magistrate Judge's October 23, 2009 Order Vacating Hearing
5 on Plaintiff's Renewed Motion for Default Judgment and Deeming Matter Submitted for Decision
6 in full.

7 2. Rafael C. Rivera, Mario Chavez Cabrera, and Peter Halamandaris are held in default.

8 3. A judgment by default is hereby entered against any right, title, or interest in the
9 defendants Approximately \$20,000.00 in U.S. Currency and One Cashier's Check in the Amount
10 of \$20,000.00 issued from the Bank of Stockton of Rafael C. Rivera, Mario Chavez Cabrera, and
11 Peter Halamandaris, and all other potential claimants who have not filed claims in this action.

12 4. A final judgment is hereby entered forfeiting all right, title, and interest in the
13 defendants Approximately \$20,000.00 in U.S. Currency and One Cashier's Check in the Amount
14 of \$20,000.00 issued from the Bank of Stockton to the United States of America, to be disposed of
15 according to law, including all right, title, and interest of Rafael C. Rivera, Mario Chavez Cabrera,
16 and Peter Halamandaris.

17 5. All parties shall bear their own costs and attorneys' fees.
