Plaintiff has consented to 16 17 magistrate judge jurisdiction pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(c)(1). (Doc. #4.) 18 Plaintiff initiated this action on November 24, 2008. (Doc. #1.) On May 11, 2009, the Court 19 screened Plaintiff's complaint pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A and dismissed Plaintiff's complaint 20 for failure to state any claims. (Doc. #11.) The Court granted Plaintiff leave to file an amended 21 complaint that was due by June 15, 2009. Plaintiff has not filed an amended complaint nor provided 22 any indication to the Court that he is intending to file an amended complaint. 23 Plaintiff was notified of the deficiencies in his claims in the May 11, 2009 screening order. 24 Because Plaintiff has not filed an amended complaint, the Court is left with little option other than 25 dismissal of the claims made in the complaint without prejudice for failure to state any claims upon which the Court can grant relief. 26 27 /// 28 ///
