In the present case, the Court does not find the required exceptional circumstances. Even if it is assumed that Plaintiff is not well versed in the law and that he has made serious allegations which, if proved, would entitle him to relief, his case is not exceptional. This Court is faced with similar cases almost daily. Plaintiff has demonstrated that he is capable of litigating this action. The claims in this action are not legally complex, as it involves an alleged excessive force incident and subsequent failure to provide medical treatment.

For the foregoing reasons, Plaintiff's motion for the appointment of counsel is HEREBY DENIED, without prejudice.
