The matter was referred to a United States 19 Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 On October 18, 2013, findings and a recommendation were entered, recommending that 21 Plaintiff's motion for transfer be denied. (Doc. 116.) On November 6, 2013, Plaintiff filed 22 objections to the findings and recommendation. (Doc. 119.) 23 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 304, this 24 Court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, 25 including Plaintiff's objections, the Court finds the findings and recommendation to be 26 supported by the record and proper analysis. 27 /// 28 ///
