However, and perhaps based on erroneous information, Plaintiff improperly served the United States District Attorney for the Eastern District of California by using standard mail, rather than certified or registered mail. Rule 4(i)(1)(A) states that service on the United States attorney for the district where the action is brought must be made either personally or by registered/certified mail. Plaintiff has demonstrated that he has properly served two of the three necessary entities and earnestly attempted service on the third. Therefore, the Court DISCHARGES the Order to Show Cause. Plaintiff will be granted an additional thirty (30) days to complete service on the United States Attorney for the Eastern District of California by certified or registered mail.
