11	of CSP-Cor.				
12	Based on the foregoing, it is HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's motion for subpoena				
13	duces tecum, filed February 8, 2011, is GRANTED. A subpoena will issue from this Court to be				
14	served by the United States Marshal pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 45 after fifteen				
15	(15) days from the date of service of this order.
