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15	Plaintiff Herman D. Shead is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this	
16	civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States	
17	Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 72-302.	
18	On September 8, 2009, the Magistrate Judge screened Plaintiff's complaint and	
19	recommended dismissal of certain claims and defendants. 28 U.S.C. § 1915A. Plaintiff filed timely	
20	objections on October 1, 2009.	
21	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a	
22	<u>de novo</u> review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings	
23	and Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.	
24	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:	
25	1. The Findings and Recommend	dations, filed September 8, 2009, is adopted in full;
26	2. This action shall proceed against defendant Vang for use of excessive force in the	
27	course of subduing Plaintiff do	uring his diabetic seizure;
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1	3.	Plaintiff's First Amendment claim against Defendants Fogle, Bradford and Vera for
2		retaliation and conspiracy to maintain silence and cover up Vang's excessive use of
3		force are dismissed, with prejudice, for failure to state a claim upon which relief may
4		be granted under § 1983;
5	4.	Plaintiff's claim for declaratory relief is dismissed with prejudice;
6	5.	Plaintiff's request for appointment of counsel is denied;
7	6.	Plaintiff's claims against Defendants in their official capacities are dismissed with
8		prejudice;
9	7.	The Court shall exercise supplemental jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. § 1367(a) over
10		Plaintiff's state tort claim against Defendant Vang, arising from Vang's assault on
11		Plaintiff;
12	8	The Court will not exercise supplemental jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. § 1367(a) over
13		Plaintiff's other state claims (Cal. Const. art. I, §17; Cal. Gov't Code § 815.6; Cal.
14		Gov't Code § 820.4; and Cal. Code regs. tit. 15, § 23268(b)), none of which state a
15		cause of action for which relief may be granted;
16	9.	The Court will not exercise supplemental jurisdiction over Plaintiff's state claims
17		against Fogle, Bradford, and Vera; and
18	10.	The Clerk of Court shall reflect on the docket the dismissal of Defendants Fogle,
19		Bradford, and Vera.
