However, plaintiff's application to proceed in forma pauperis was deficient in 14 that it did not include plaintiff's signature in the appropriate area of the form. Each document 15 submitted for filing must include the original signature of the filing party or parties. Local Rule 16 7-131; F.R.C.P. 11(a). 17 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 18 Within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this order, plaintiff shall re-submit the 19 20 enclosed application to proceed in forma pauperis, with plaintiff's original signature in the 21 appropriate area of the form, or in the alternative, pay the \$350.00 filing fee for this action.
