

1 JHMES96685S009667, License: 5NJS481 were seized in the city of Turlock, in Stanislaus County,
2 California. The Drug Enforcement Administration (“DEA”) published notice of the nonjudicial
3 forfeiture of the defendant currency and defendant vehicle on September 29, October 6, and 13, 2008
4 in the *Wall Street Journal*.

5 4. Plaintiff proposes that publication be made as follows:

- 6 a. One publication;
- 7 b. Thirty (30) consecutive days;
- 8 c. On the official internet government forfeiture site www.forfeiture.gov;
- 9 d. The publication is to include the following:

- 10 (1) The Court and case number of the action;
- 11 (2) The date of the arrest/seizure;
- 12 (3) The identity and/or description of the property arrested/seized;
- 13 (4) The name and address of the attorney for the Plaintiff;
- 14 (5) A statement that claims of persons entitled to possession or claiming

15 an interest pursuant to Supplemental Rule G(5) must be filed with the Court and served on the
16 attorney for the Plaintiff no later than 60 days after the first day of publication on the official internet
17 government forfeiture site; and

18 (6) A statement that answers to the Complaint or a motion under Rule 12
19 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure ("Fed. R. Civ. P.") must be filed and served within 20 days

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2 after the filing of the claims and, in the absence thereof, default may be entered and condemnation
3 ordered.
