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17	On March 17, 2016, the parties filed a fully executed stipulation for voluntary dismissal of		
18	this action with prejudice. (Doc. 330.) The Court issued an order dismissing the action pursuant		
19	to that stipulation the next day. (Doc. 331.) Approximately a week later, Plaintiff filed a notice of		
20	withdrawal of his consent to the terms of the settlement in which he moved to stay entry of final		
21	judgment in this action until the terms of the settlement are met which was denied for lack of		
22	jurisdiction on April 7, 2016. (Docs. 332, 336.)		
23	On April 11, 2016, Plaintiff filed a second motion for withdrawal of the stipulation for		
24	dismissal which raised the same arguments as his first motion. (Doc. 336.) The Court notes that		
25	Plaintiff signed his second motion on April 2, 2016 and gave to prison staff for mailing on April 4,		
26	2016. (Doc. 336.) Plaintiff had not received the ruling on his first motion seeking relief from the		
27	settlement when he mailed the second. It is apparent that the order on Plaintiff's first motion and		
28	his second motion crossed in the mail.		

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1	Based on the foregoing, the Court ORDERS :		
2	1. Plaintiff's motion for withdrawal of stipulation for dismissal, filed on April 11, 2016		
3	(Doc. 336), is DISREGARDED as moot.
