**CLERK TO REJECT ALL
FURTHER FILINGS**

On May 2, 2018, this Court issued an order denying Plaintiff’s motion to enforce the settlement stipulation for lack of jurisdiction. (Doc. 341.) That order explicitly stated, “**No further filings will be accepted in this case.**” (*Id.*, p. 2 (emphasis in original).) The same day, Plaintiff filed a motion seeking injunctive relief. (Doc. 342.)

As stated in the May 2, 2018 order, federal courts are courts of limited jurisdiction; they possess only that power authorized by Constitution and statute, and it is presumed that a cause lies outside this limited jurisdiction. *Kokkonen v. Guardian Life Ins. Co.*, 511 U.S. 375, 378 (1994) (quotation marks and citations omitted). This Court’s jurisdiction over this matter ceased upon dismissal of the action on March 17, 2016. (*See* Doc. 331.)

Based on the foregoing, the Court **ORDERS** that Plaintiff’s motion for injunctive relief, filed on May 2, 2018 (Doc. 342), is **STRICKEN** from the record in this action. **THE CLERK**
