1	On October 19, 2009, the Court heard the Motion to Allow Extra Record Evidence to		
2	Explain Technical Terms and Complex Subject Matter filed by California Department of Water		
3	Resources and its Director, Lester Snow (collectively "DWR") (Doc. Nos. 156; 345);		
4	Having fully considered the briefs and oral arguments submitted by the parties, and good		
5	cause appearing therefore, THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS:		
6	DWR's Motion to Allow Extra Record Evidence to Explain Technical Terms and Complex		
7	Subject Matter Motion is GRANTED with respect to its request to present testimony by a DWR		
8	expert concerning DWR's CALSIM II Simulation Modeling, because DWR made a threshold		
9	showing of the materiality of such testimony.		
10	The Court will allow a DWR expert to file a declaration explaining why comparing the		
11	historical data to CALSIM II -modeled data is not a scientifically acceptable practice (not "best		
12	available science"), and thus why the Service's comparison of historic data with modeled data		
13	resulted in an inaccurate determination of the change in X2 attributable to future project		
14	operations.		
15	To establish that the Service's comparison of data modeled by CALSIM II with actual		
16	historic data resulted in a materially flawed analysis, the Court will allow DWR's expert to		
17	explain the CALSIM II modeling program, and explain the extent to which the modeling data can		
18	be appropriately used to assess the effect of future project operations on X2 and delta smelt		
19	habitat.		
20	This order is without prejudice to the Defendants and Defendant-Intervenors' ability to		
21	object to the admissibility of the testimony in the declaration.		
22	Subject to further order of the Court, the declaration shall be filed and served on or before		
23	November 13, 2009.
