5 1. The parties are to meet and confer to determine whether interim remedies
6 issues can be resolved without a hearing and are to report the results of the meet and
7 confer to the Court during a further scheduling conference on November 25, 2009 at 9:00
8 a.m. As part of the meet and confer, plaintiffs, through counsel for plaintiffs San Luis &
9 Delta-Mendota Water Authority and Westlands Water District, shall circulate their
10 proposed interim remedy to all parties by close of business Friday, November 20, 2009.

A further scheduling conference regarding interim remedies is set for

 The parties may appear telephonically.

14 3. California Department of Water Resources (DWR) shall circulate a proposed 15 stipulation to file a complaint in intervention. All other parties shall respond by close of 16 business Tuesday, November 24, 2009, advising whether they will stipulate to the filing of 17 the complaint in intervention. If all parties so stipulate, the stipulation and complaint in 18 intervention shall be filed November 25, 2009, and DWR shall be deemed a plaintiff in 19 these consolidated cases. If the parties do not agree to the stipulation, any motion for 20 leave to file the complaint in intervention shall be filed and served on or before December 21 1, 2009; any opposition shall be filed and served on or before December 4, 2009; and the 22 motion shall be heard on December 7, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. in Courtroom 3 before the 23 Honorable Oliver W. Wanger.

24 4. The briefing schedule regarding expert declarations and motions for25 summary judgment is modified as follows:
